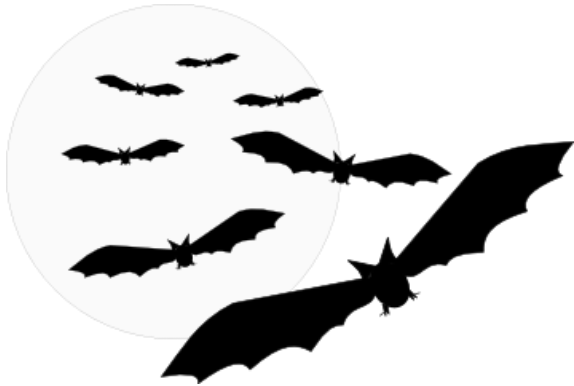

Bats in the Belfry

Monday 16th April: 7.30-9.30pm

“Church towers, and particularly cathedral bell chambers, are ideal for locating bats” says David Endacott, bat expert for over twenty years and Chairman of the Oxfordshire Bat Group. Bats are the only mammals capable of sustained flight, and all eighteen UK bats are protected species.

David’s lively and highly informative talk will be ‘illustrated’ by the live rescued bats he will be bringing along, plus a bat detector so that we can hear them.
