#### Thames Rivercruise trip - Saturday 29th June 2024, 11.00am

To celebrate 50 years of the Bracknell Forest Natural History Society, we've organised a 90 minute cruise for Members, from Caversham Pier through to Mapledurham Lock and Weir. This is the river as it should be, tranquil and stunning... in *Wind in the Willows* country. Following the Thames upstream, the journey will feel a world away from life in Reading and the surrounding towns. You will see wildlife, open countryside, islands and look out towards the Berkshire Downs. There'll be plenty of time to relax, spot a variety of bird and animal species - and enjoy the Thames in all its glory.



The boat will leave Caversham Pier at 11.00am, please meet by the pier at 10.45am. Free parking very near the pier is at Thameside Promenade, postcode RG1 8EQ. Parking may be busy, so please allow extra time to find a slot. If you would like a lift please let me know, and this can be arranged. There are onboard toilets on the vessel.
