Join us on a visit to the Wildfowl & Wetlands Trust's 65 acre haven for wildlife in West Sussex - surrounded by the South Downs, overlooked by dramatic Arundel Castle, and with the river Arun at its borders.

As well as the usual over-wintering wildfowl such as teal, gadwell and shelduck, there's a chance of spotting rarer Bewick's swans, bitterns and water rail amongst others. And

you may enjoy taking a ride on the Boat Safari through the reed beds to increase the possibility of your spotting kingfishers and water voles.

Take a lunch break at **The Water's Edge Cafe** with panoramic views of the Arun.
Hot meals are served between noon and 2.00pm.
