## Join us for a trip to the Hawk Conservancy, Andover

**Date: Saturday 24<sup>th</sup> March 2018**

**Depart from South Hill Park car park: 10am** (expected arrival 11am)

**Leave from Hawk Conservancy: 5pm** (expected back at SHP 6pm)

**Entry Fee: £14.65 adult or £12.95 senior** – payable on arrival



This visit to the Hawk Conservancy is a follow up to our talk on 19<sup>th</sup> March. The Trust is set in 22 acres of woodland and wildflower meadow, and is home to more than 50 species of birds of prey such as owls, kites, hawks, eagles and vultures. You'll be able to explore the huge mixed aviary, study many of these magnificent birds face-to-face, watch them feeding – and experience for yourself a number of magnificent flying displays. Here's the schedule for the day of our visit:

11.30am – **World of Birds of Prey flying display**

12.15am – **Opportunity to meet an owl**

2pm – **Valley of the Eagles flying display**

3pm - **Opportunity for adults to fly a Harris Hawk**

3.45pm – **Woodland Owls flying display**

4.45pm – **Steller's Sea-Eagles feeding, and keeper's talk**
